



# IDVA Career and Technical Education Scholarship

## Academic Scholarship Criteria

- Must be a full time IDVA student graduating in SY2019-20
- Must attend one of the IDVA graduation ceremonies
- Cumulative weighted GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Demonstrated contribution to IDVA and/or local community
- One scholarship of \$1,200 will be awarded

## Application Process

Students must submit an application letter to the scholarship committee. The letter (no longer than two typed pages, double-spaced) should address the following:

- First and Last Name
- Scholarship for which the student is applying
- Plans for post-secondary education
- Explanation of how your education at Idaho Virtual Academy has prepared you for life beyond high school
- How a scholarship to a Technical Certificate Program or Career School can help you achieve your goals
- Description of contributions to IDVA and/or local community

## Scholarship Details:

For students graduating in January 2020, completed scholarships must be submitted by January 15, 2020. For students graduating in May 2020, completed applications must be submitted by April 24, 2020. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted. We encourage you to apply for all the scholarships you are eligible, and only one IDVA scholarship will be awarded to a student. The funds will be awarded to student upon admission to an accredited institution of higher education. Check will be made out to such institution for benefit of the student upon confirmation of enrollment. Recipients will be announced during the graduation ceremonies in each region.
