## IDLA SUMMER SCHOOL REGISTRATION BEGINS TODAY

### 2019 Summer School Information

Note: If you failed a high school math or history course and need to recover that credit, you will need to sign up for that class through IDLA as well. (If you failed a high school English or science course, then you can sign up for those through IDVA and the information on how to do that will be sent to you in a separate email.)

**Advanced, Dual Credit (DC), or Overload:** Please read below to find out if you qualify to use Fast Forward Program & Advanced Opportunities (AO) funds to pay for your summer course(s).

**This email contains instructions for how to register online for your summer course on April 1<sup>st</sup> when registration opens. Registration codes are provided below.** Please note, not all summer courses meet NCAA guidelines. If you are considering participating in NCAA, check with your counselor/advisor to see if your course qualifies. If you have questions about course options, or which course you need to take, please contact your counselor/advisor.

DC courses are also available. Schedule Advisor approval will be required for DC courses. Your AO funds (explained below) will cover the cost of any DC IDLA summer course you take.

Payment Assistance with the Fast Forward Program & AO:

**-Overload Courses:** An overload course is a high school course taken in **EXCESS** of a student's full school schedule. You qualify to have your summer school fees covered for up to two courses (a \$130 value). ***If you use Fast Forward funds for summer school, you must pass 12 credits during the 2019-20 school year (6 classes per semester).***

**-Dual Credit AO:** The Fast Forward Program will cover \$65 per credit of each IDLA DC course. If you have failed a DC course in which you have previously used funds, you must pay out of pocket for a like-course before accessing AO funds again. Eligibility for taking a dual credit course requires you to have a 3.0 or higher GPA. If you have questions, please reach out to Mrs. Bannister or your counselor.

Registration opens April 1, 2019 and will close on May 24th. Courses fill up quickly, so register as soon as you can.

- **Course Dates:**
  - High School Courses: June 3rd-August 16<sup>th</sup>. Finals will be held the last week of the course. (August 12<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup>)
  - DC Courses: June 3<sup>rd</sup>-August 30<sup>th</sup>. Finals will be held the last week of the course. (August 26<sup>th</sup>-August 30<sup>th</sup>)
  - Note: All Summer courses will have a break week July 1-5 as systems will be unavailable due to maintenance.
- **Where:**
  - Virtual courses- internet connection required
- **Cost:**
  - High School Courses=\$75
  - Dual Credit Courses=\$65 per credit, paid directly to college.
  - Full payment due no later than May 24<sup>th</sup>.
- **Qualifications:**
  - To take an IDLA course, you will be required to complete an online orientation prior to starting. The orientation course is free. ***You will be removed from the class if the orientation is not completed by May 31<sup>st</sup>.***
  - **Note: If you have taken an IDLA course before, you will not be required to take the orientation again.**
